### **School Garden & Wildlife Habitat Grant**

The Audubon Society of Central Maryland (ASCM) is pleased to announce that it will be funding up to four \$500 grants in the 2009-2010 school year for public and private schools with plans to create wildlife habitat or native plant gardens. Primary and secondary schools and nature centers in Carroll, Frederick, and Howard County are eligible to apply. Last year's grant recipients were Century High School in Sykesville, Ilchester Elementary School in Ellicott City, Pointers Run Elementary School in Clarksville, and Walkersville High School in Walkersville. Interested school officials and students should complete an ASCM application, detailing the goals of the project, including education and conservation benefits.
